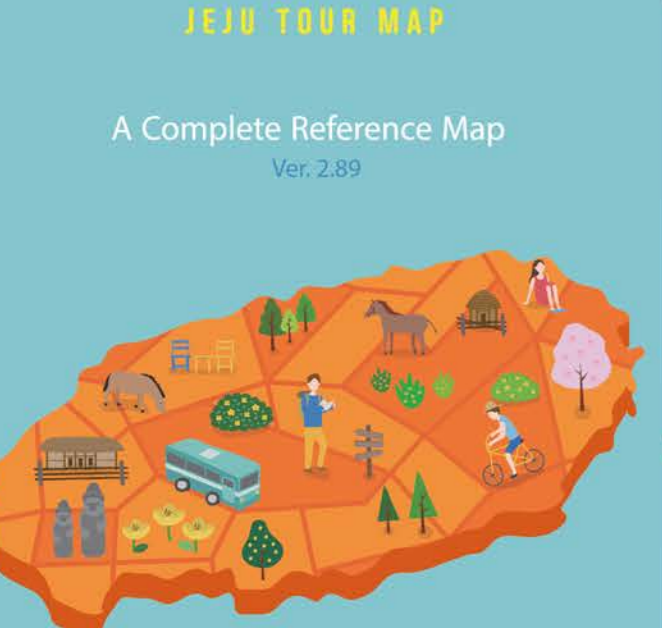

* You can only reach the peak of Hallasan through the Seongsanpak and Gwaneumsa courses via Baeknoddam. (The other courses only go up to Wise Orem Shelter.)

* You need a reservation to climb the Seongsanpak Course and Gwaneumsa Course.

F Seongsan Ilchulbong (Sunrise Peak)

This tuff cone formed when an underwater volcano erupted in the middle of the ocean. It was designated as a national monument due to its high preservation value. It was registered as a UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site in 2007 and UNESCO Global Geopark Site in 2010.

G Geomun Orem

Geomun Orem is the only orem on Jeju Island that is a UNESCO World Natural Heritage. The volcanic terrain and lava caves have extremely high geological value.

H Yongmeori Coast

Yongmeori is a sandstone beach created by layers of sand that have been deposited for tens of millions of years. The mysterious scenery of the coast is enough to make anyone who witnesses it exclaim in wonder.

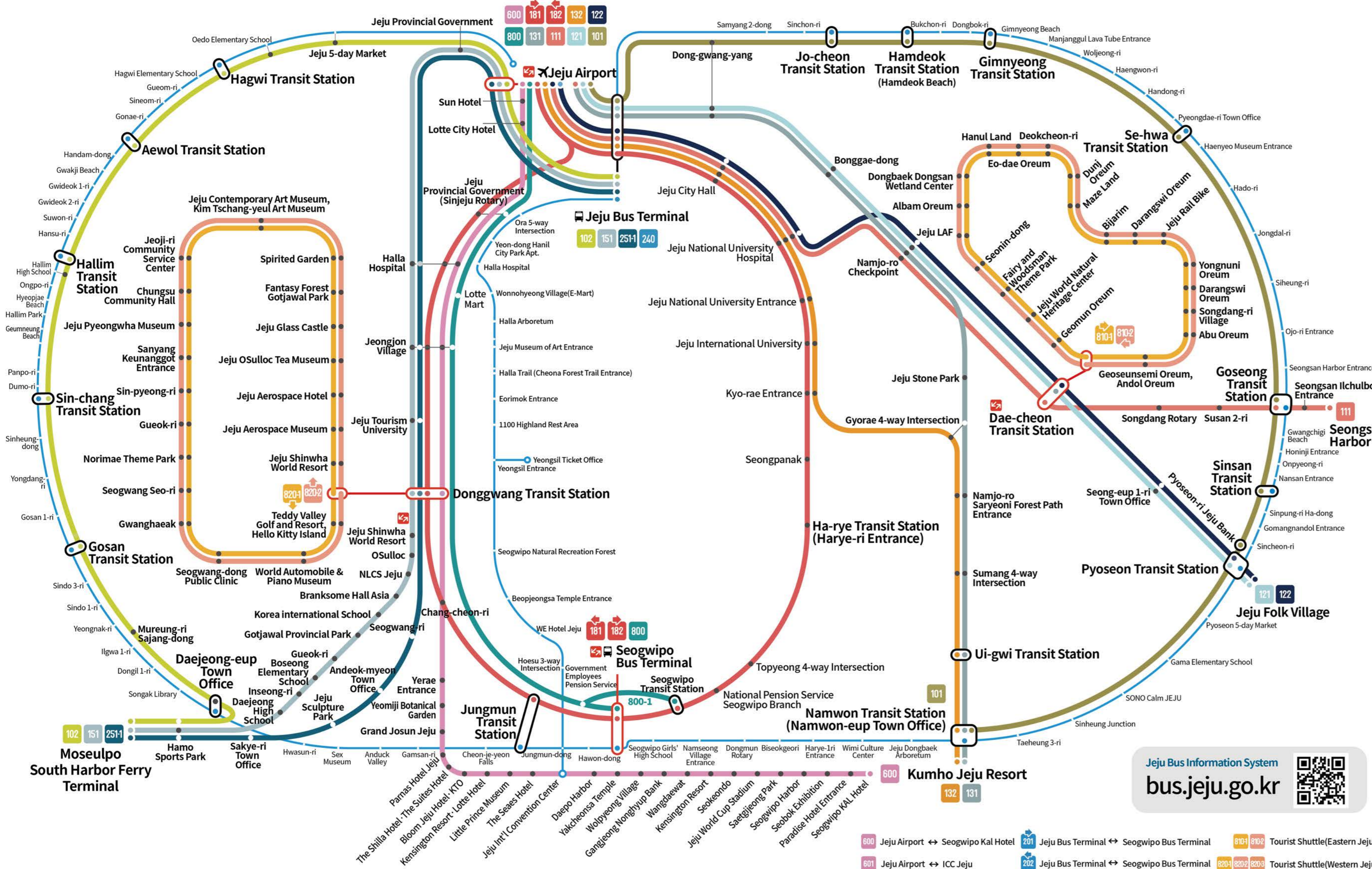




Express and Trunkline Bus Route Map

Please be sure to abide by the rules

- Cross the street at a crosswalk.**
 - When there is a traffic light, cross at the green light.
 - When there is no traffic light, look left and right and then cross.
- Put waste into a waste bin.**
 - Separately collect waste by kind, including plastic bags for snacks or bottles for beverages, and place them in the designated recycling bins.
 - Smokers must place cigarette butts in the designated ashtrays or waste bins.
- Do not spit in the streets, at tourist attractions, or in public places.**
 - Even when you have a cold, spit phlegm into a toilet or cover your mouth with tissue and spit into it before throwing the tissue into the trash can.
 - Others may feel uncomfortable upon seeing you spit in a public place.
- Use a toilet to urinate or defecate.**
 - Both men and women must urinate or defecate in the designated toilets.
 - A fine of 50,000 KRW will be imposed on anyone defecating or urinating on a street, a tourist attraction, or a public place.
- Follow etiquette in a public place.**
 - Do not expose or intentionally show off a horrible tattoo in public.
 - Do not make noise by talking loudly in a place with a number of people including in restaurants.
 - Do not make others feel uncomfortable by walking around naked in public.
- No smoking in a public place or a nature reserve including Mt. Halla National Park.**
 - Forest fires cause severe damage to other humans as well as the animals and plants that live in the environment.
 - In particular, do not enter restricted areas without reasonable cause.
 - * Smoking in a national park will be subject to fines of up to 100,000 KRW.

How to Report to 119(National 119 Rescue Services)

- Report the location of the injured person.**
 - Give the address of the location or the name of a big building around the location or a well-defined landmark. Be specific when describing the location to the operator, for example, "The injured person is in the basement of 00."
- Explain precisely what and how it happened.**
 - Do not make others feel uncomfortable by talking loudly in a place with a number of people including in restaurants.
 - Do not make others feel uncomfortable by walking around naked in public.
- Explain the patient's status specifically.**
 - For example, tell the operator, "The patient is bleeding from the head." Also, explain specifically if a first-aid treatment is done by saying for example, "The bleeding area is being pressed firmly."
- Potential Danger and Hazards.**
 - Report any dangerous situations or events such as fire, accident, potential collapsing of a structure or building, toxic dusts or gas leak, danger of explosion or electric shock or a traffic accident.
- Stay connected!**
 - If you call 119, do not hang up the phone until the 119 call taker says it is okay to hang up. Be sure to give your name and telephone number to the 119 call taker. Stay connected until an ambulance arrives at the accident site.
